Featuring the most wonderful self-portraits of all the children at Broomley First School with a decorative border to celebrate our school community at the time of King Charles III's Coronation.

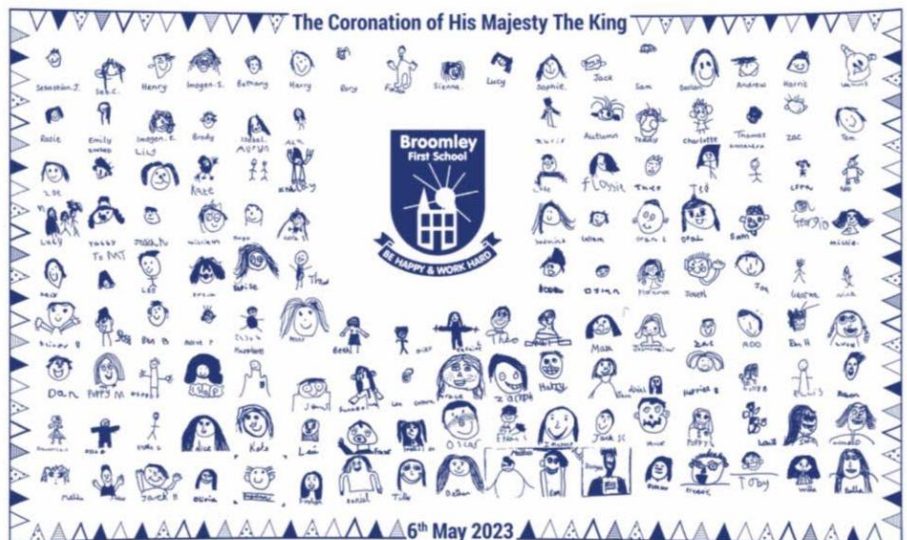
This is a lovely memento and only available to pre-order so don't miss out - order your tea towel now! Each tea towel costs £5.

CORONATION CELEBRATION DAY:

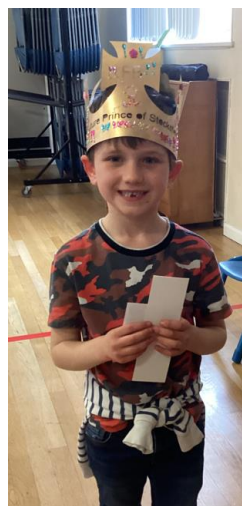
